Eric Chin is an Assistant Professor of Neurology, Neurological Surgery, and Pediatrics at Kennedy Krieger Institute and the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine.

As a child neurologist and neurodevelopmental physician, he cares for children and adults with cerebral palsy as part of a multidisciplinary team at the Kennedy Krieger Institute Phelps Center for Cerebral Palsy and Neurodevelopmental Medicine.

As a physician-scientist with a background in Computational and Neural Systems, he leads mechanistic, translational, and clinical research projects focused on understanding and treating pain in individuals with cerebral palsy. He employs a patient-centered deep phenotyping approach seeking to understand the mechanisms underlying individual differences in pain profiles to, ultimately, deliver effective precision care.
